In the bid process, two prices were requested from each bidder; one bid for work to be completed this fall and a second bid for work to be completed in the spring of 2020. Evaluation of the bids received showed a savings of approximately nine percent for the work to be completed in the spring of 2020 versus the fall of 2019. Due to the cost savings the roof will be replaced in the spring of 2020. The following is a tabulation of the bids received:

Justification:

In July of 2016, the Fire Department purchased two sets of Hurst E-Draulic extrication tools for Engine 1 and Engine 2. This purchase was funded through a grant award from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security FEMA – Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) program. Improvements in technology have produced a new generation of extrication tools that are battery powered and produce cutting pressures over 10 times greater than the tools currently carried on Engine 4. Additionally, the move to battery powered units eliminates the need for hydraulic hoses and pumps which will provide improved mobility and greater flexibility for firefighters when operating on emergency scenes. The purchase of this new tool will complete the placement of the most advanced extrication equipment available on all three of the fire department's front line engines and it will improve operating efficiencies through the standardization of equipment and greater interoperability.

On October 17, 2019, the Fire Department received a quote of \$11,500 from Apollo Fire Equipment Company for the purchase of one E-Draulic Combination Tool manufactured by Hurst Jaws of Life, Inc. Apollo Fire Equipment Company is the sole source provider for Hurst extrication equipment for our region.

Justification:

A supplied breathing air system provides a constant and sustained supply of breathing air for firefighters when they are using self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) at technical rescue incidents. While operating at incidents such as structural collapses and confined space entrapments, it is necessary to provide breathing air to firefighters through a supply hose line instead of a standard compressed breathing air cylinder. Working space constraints and extended time periods working in a hazardous environment necessitate the use of supplied breathing air systems.

Avon Protection manufactures a supplied air breathing system that is specifically designed to be used with our new Avon Protection SCBAs. The system includes an airline manifold with pressure regulators and all of the necessary compatible fittings for our SCBAs.

On October 25, 2019, the Fire Department received a quote of \$2,998 from Douglass Safety Systems for one supplied air breathing system manufactured by Avon Protection. Douglass Safety Systems is the sole source provider for Avon Protection equipment for the State of Michigan.

The grant will be utilized to prepare a feasibility study for the completion of the layout, design and topographical survey for approximately 1 mile of the Iron Belle Trail that will connect the Saginaw Riverfront Trail / Iron Belle Trail at the intersection of Janes Avenue and Water Street to the start of the Iron Belle Trail in Carrollton Township at the intersection of Carrollton Road and Weiss Street. The study will include three possible options for the route of the Iron Belle Trail. Once the route is determined, the consultant will complete a preliminary design complete with a topographical survey.

The IBT was created in 2013 by Governor Snyder to highlight Michigan's natural, historic, and cultural resources as well as the communities they traverse, with an overall goal of linking the wealth of Michigan's existing trails, while promoting partnerships to develop and maintain segments of the IBT. The Iron Belle Trail spans from Belle Isle in Detroit to Ironwood in the western Upper Peninsula.

This agreement allows for reimbursement up to a maximum of \$24,780 or the actual cost, whichever is less.

WHEREAS: at an election held November 4, 2014, voters renewed the authorization for City Council to create a special assessment district consisting of the entire City of Saginaw and levy up to 7.5 mills on the taxable value of all real property in the district for a period of 5 years, from 2016 through 2020, inclusive, to fund police and fire services for the City of Saginaw; and

WHEREAS: said 5 year period expires on December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS: because of economic conditions and because of the need to continue to provide police and fire services to the citizens of the City of Saginaw it is necessary that a levy of up to 7.5 mills on the taxable value of all real property in the district approved by the voters on March 10, 2020 be reestablished for a period of 5 years from 2021 through 2025, inclusive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a proposal to renew the special assessment district, that being the entire City of Saginaw approved by the voters on November 4, 2014, and levy up to 7.5 mills on the taxable value of the real property in the district for a duration of 5 years from 2021 through 2025, inclusive, be placed before the qualified electors of the City of Saginaw on the ballot for the Presidential Primary Election to be held Tuesday, March 10, 2020; and

Manager's Recommendation:

I recommend adoption of a resolution adopting Complete Streets principles and practices to create a transportation network in the City of Saginaw that considers multi-modal transportation.

Justification:

Road design that incorporates Complete Streets principles and practices includes context sensitive design framework and infrastructure improvements that enables safe and convenient access for transportation users of all ages and disabilities, including pedestrians, bicyclists, transit riders and motor vehicle drivers.

The City currently incorporates Complete Streets principles and practices during the road design process but has never formally adopted the use of Complete Streets principles and practices. For instance, we review the condition and location of pedestrian sidewalks and ADA sidewalk ramps, and appropriate pedestrian signing during the road design process. We also discuss bus stop locations with STARS and the necessity for bus pads. Amenities that give a street a sense of place such as trees, decorative sidewalk, decorative street lights, benches and bike racks are considered in business districts. New trees are considered in residential neighborhoods. The implementation of a road diet, a decrease in the number of through traffic lanes, and the addition of bike lanes is considered where traffic volumes have decreased. Shared use lanes are also considered.

Formally adopting the use of Complete Streets principles and practices will assure that the City continues to use Complete Streets principles and practices during the road design process and formally align the City's road design principles and practices with Federal and State road design principles and practices.

ADOPTION OF COMPLETE STREETS PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICES

Moved by Council Member _____, seconded by Council Member _____ to adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS: The City of Saginaw shall ensure that all users of our transportation system have the opportunity to travel safely and conveniently on all streets and roadways within the public right-of-way in Saginaw; and

WHEREAS: Creation and maintenance of facilities that effectively accommodate non-motorized travel often reduce the risk of injury by up to 30%; and

WHEREAS: Complete Streets is an inclusive context sensitive design framework and infrastructure that enables safe and convenient access for transportation users of all ages and disabilities, including pedestrians, bicyclists, transit riders, and motor vehicle drivers; and

WHEREAS: Complete Streets are achieved when transportation agencies routinely plan, design, construct, reconstruct, operate, and maintain the transportation network to improve travel conditions for bicyclists, pedestrians, transit and freight in a manner consistent with, and supportive of, the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS: Development of pedestrian, bicycle, and transit infrastructure offers long term cost savings and opportunities to create safe and convenient non-motorized travel; and

WHEREAS: Streets that support and invite multiple uses, including safe, active, and ample space for pedestrians, bicycles, and transit are more conducive to public life and efficient movement of people than streets designed primarily to move automobiles; and

WHEREAS: Increasing active transportation such as walking, bicycling and public transportation offers the potential for improved public health, economic development, a cleaner environment, reduced transportation costs, enhanced community connections, social equality, and more enjoyed livable communities; and

WHEREAS: Streets designed using Complete Streets principles complement and enhance ongoing active community revitalization efforts by the City and numerous community and neighborhood groups as well as education initiatives such as Safe Routes to School; and

WHEREAS: Complete Streets principles have been and continue to be adopted nationwide at state, county, MPO, and city levels in the interest of proactive planning and adherence to federal regulations that guide transportation planners to promote multi-modal transportation options and accessibility for all users.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council for the City of Saginaw does hereby agree to adopt Complete Streets policies and practices to create a transportation network in the City of Saginaw that considers multi-modal transportation.

BALLOT LANGUAGE FOR STARS MILLAGE PROPOSAL

WHEREAS: the Saginaw Transit Authority Regional Services (STARS) was created pursuant to Public Act No. 196 of 1986, as amended, to operate a transit system; and

WHEREAS: Public Act No. 196 of 1986, as amended, provides that a tax may be levied by said authority to provide public transportation if approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS: at an election held August 5, 2015, voters approved a millage renewal of up to three mills, being \$3.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property within the City of Saginaw for a period of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS: said five-year period expires in November 2020; and

WHEREAS: STARS requires a levy of a tax pursuant to Public Act No. 196 of 1986, as amended, to continue to provide public transportation services; and

WHEREAS: at its meeting on October 28, 2019, STARS Board of Directors resolved that the following question be placed on the ballot for consideration by the electorate at the Presidential Primary Election to be held Tuesday, March 10, 2020, and that it shall be substantially in the following form:

SAGINAW TRANSIT AUTHORITY REGIONAL SERVICES MILLAGE PROPOSAL

SHALL SAGINAW TRANSIT AUTHORITY REGIONAL SERVICES IMPOSE A MILLAGE OF 3.2 MILLS (\$3.20 PER \$1,000 OF TAXABLE VALUE) AGAINST ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF SAGINAW AND LEVY IT FOR FIVE (5) YEARS, 2021 THROUGH 2025 INCLUSIVE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATIONS TO PROVIDE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION, WHICH LEVY WOULD COLLECT ESTIMATED \$1,428,294.00 IN THE FIRST YEAR THE MILLAGE IS LEVIED.
