Lieutenant Kendziorski provided updates regarding the following:

- Accreditation standards can be viewed online at the Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police website.
- MCOLES implemented expanded statewide annual training requirements last year on an exploratory basis. This year, the training is required and monitored more closely to ensure agencies are adhering to the requirements or demonstrating a good effort to do so.
- A database system tracks the accreditation process and makes it easier to assign training.
- Current crime statistics for the new year-shootings are down approximately 20%.
